

'Trusted sites' fix for people with GTUF website login problems

The problem:

- Some people are having trouble with logging in to the GTUF website. What happens is that either you cannot log in at all, or else every time you click on something or try to move to another page, the site asks you to type in your password over and over again.

The possible fix:

Add GTUF as a 'trusted site' within internet explorer so hopefully it will do a better job of remembering and trusting the credentials that you have already typed in, regardless of any other security settings which may be in place on your network.

- Within internet explorer, click the 'Tools' button, then 'Internet Options'.
- In the Internet Options window, click on the 'Security' tab, then click on 'Trusted Sites', then on 'Sites'.
- In the new 'Trusted Sites' window that pops up, add these sites to the trusted zone: <http://share.gtuf.org> and <http://sharepoint.gt13e2.gtuf.org>
- You may have to first **uncheck** the box at the bottom about https: verification.
